 Numbers in parentheses are margins of error at 90% confidence level.

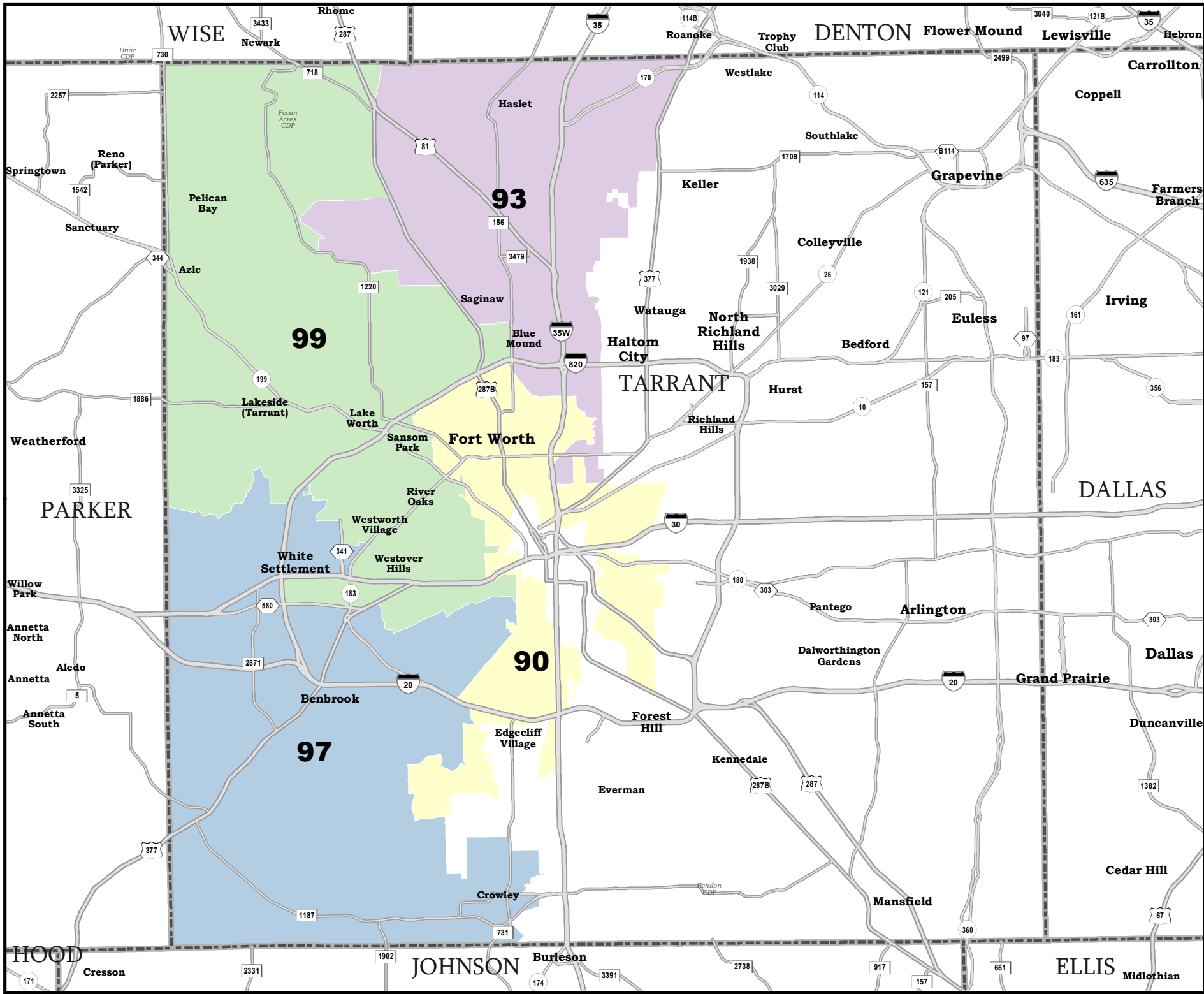
