The percent for each CVAP population category is that group's CVAP divided by the CVAP total.

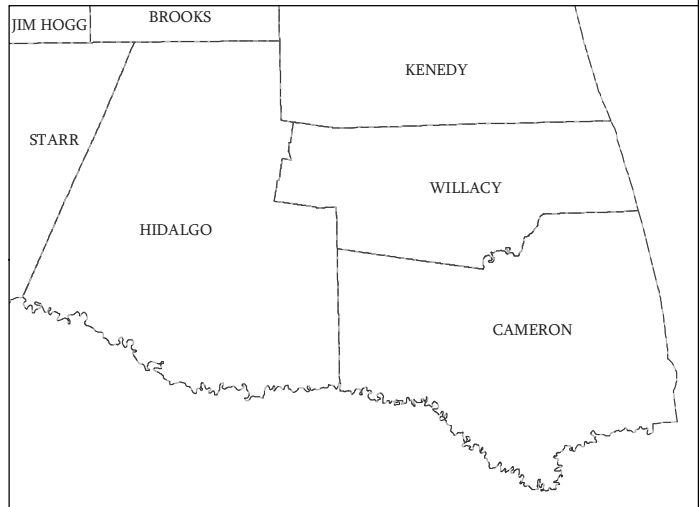
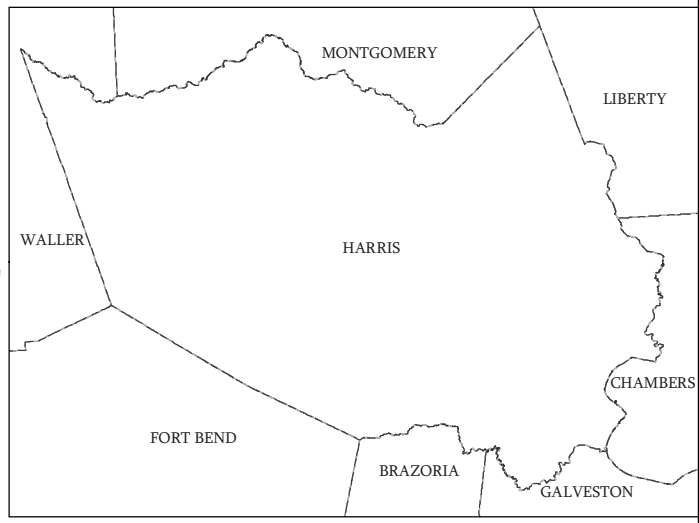
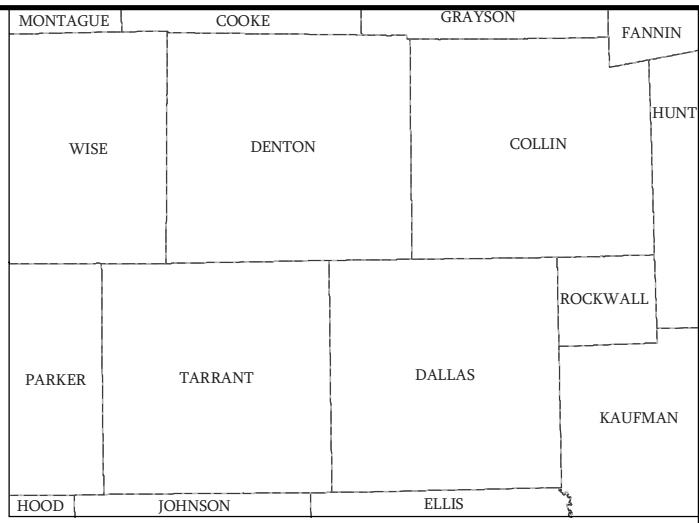
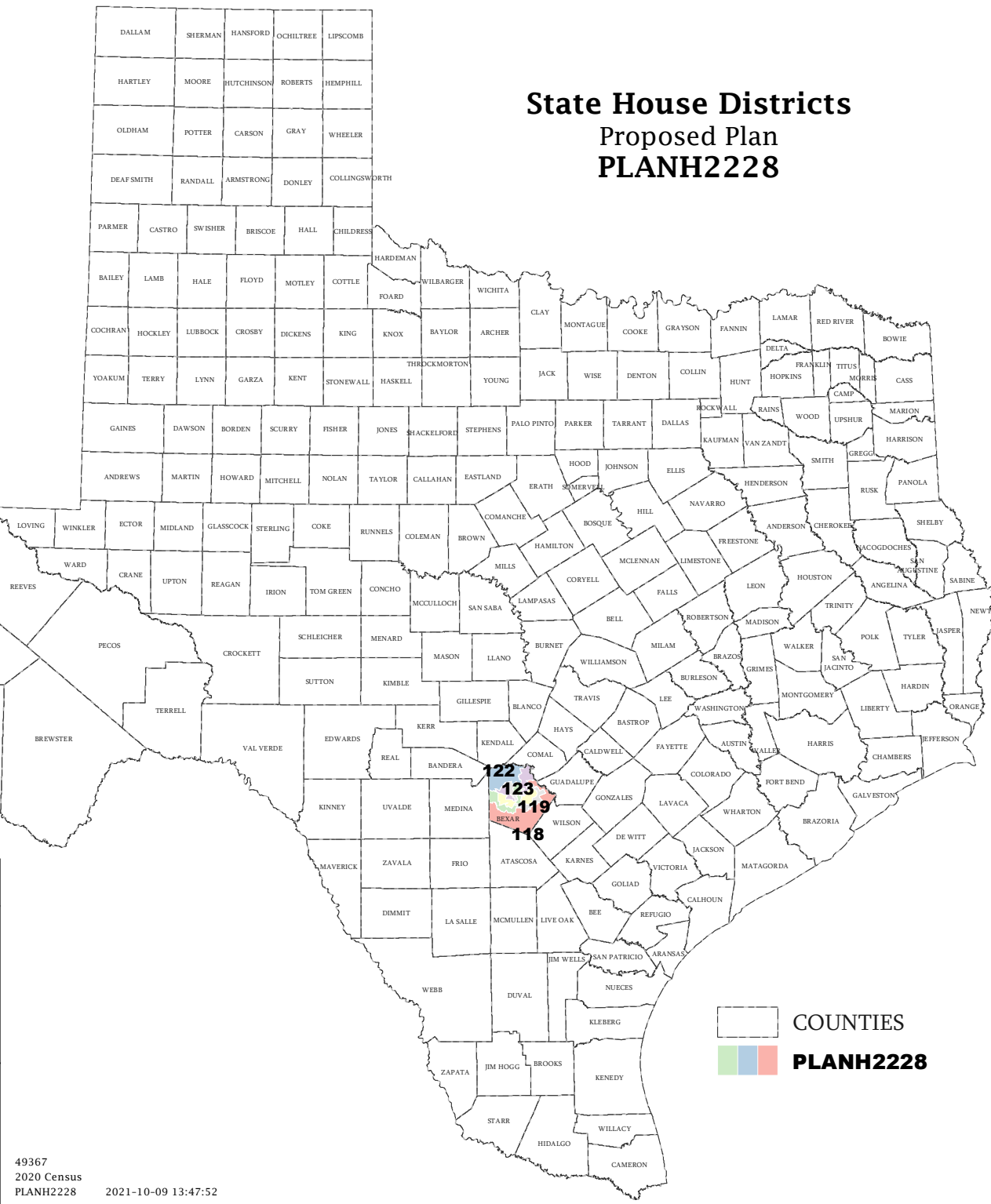
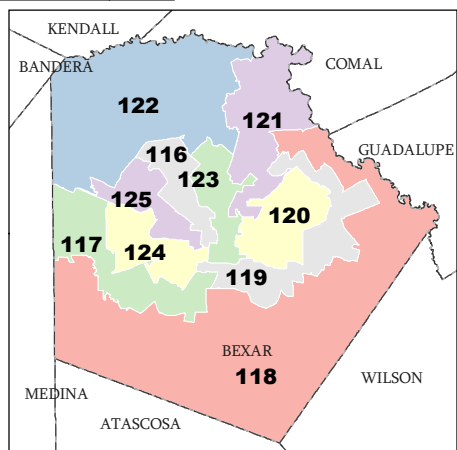
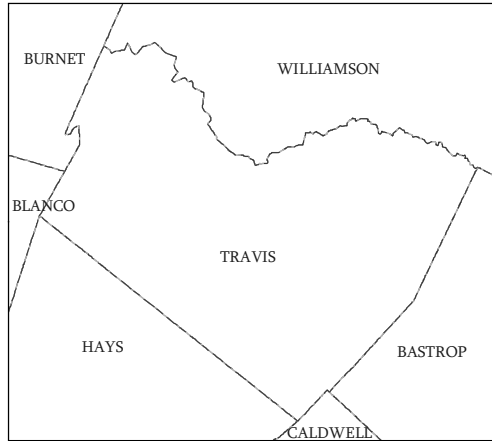

State House Districts Proposed Plan PLANH2228



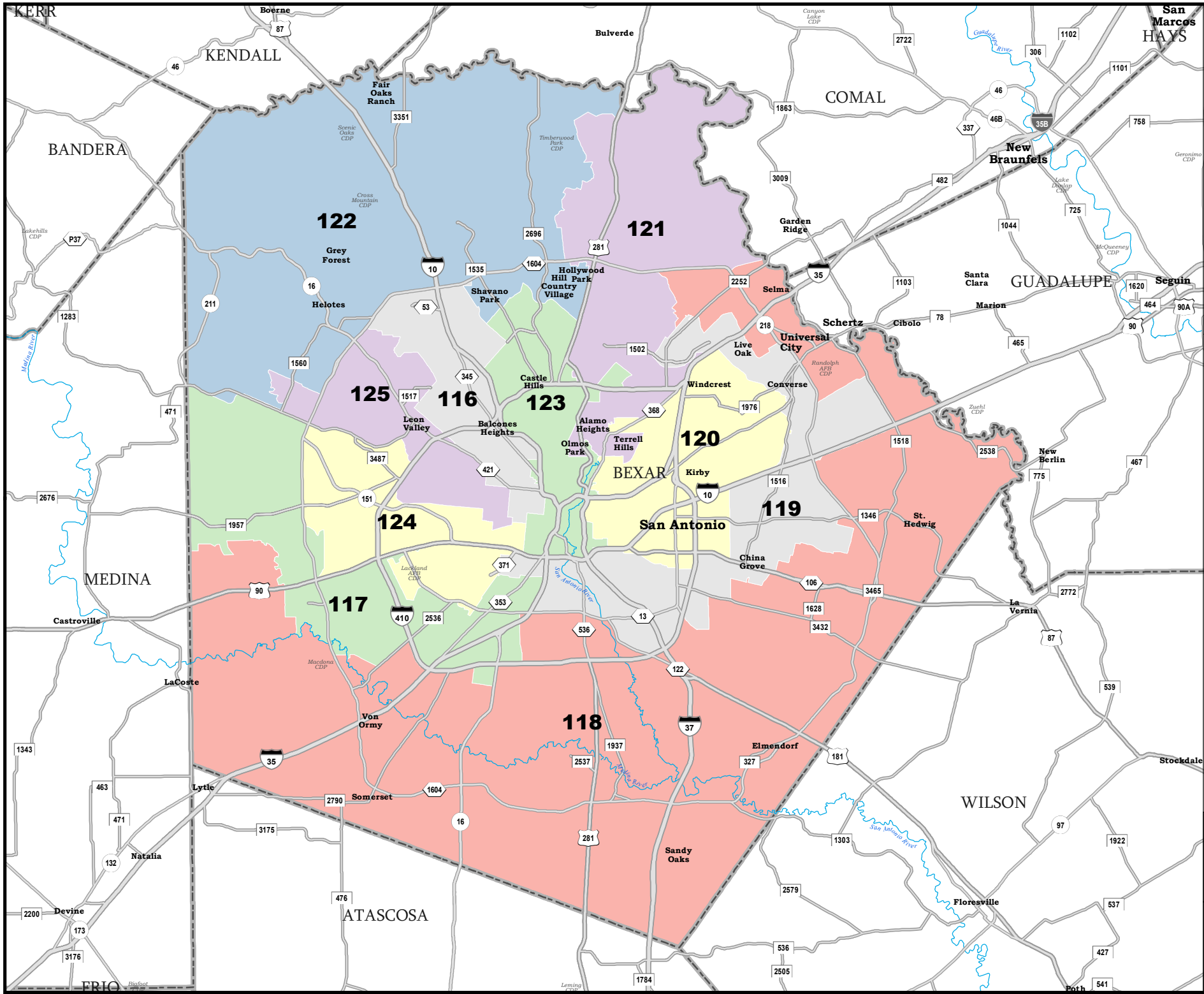
